Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics **AUGUST 2005**

Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 603,128 in August 2005, increasing by 3,980 (+0.7%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$156,548,936 in August 2005 increasing approximately \$8.1 million (+5.5%) over July 2005.

Food Stamps

Food Stamps: Recipients of Food Stamps numbered 1,744,085 in August 2005, decreasing by 267 (-0.0%) over July 2005. Food Stamps expenditures totaled \$181,000,342 in August 2005, increasing approximately \$1.2 million (+0.6%) over the previous month.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: For August 2005, SSI recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 638,367 increasing 7,101 (+1.1%) from the previous month. SSI expenditures in August totaled \$317,449,707 increasing approximately \$10.1 million (+3.3%) from July 2005.

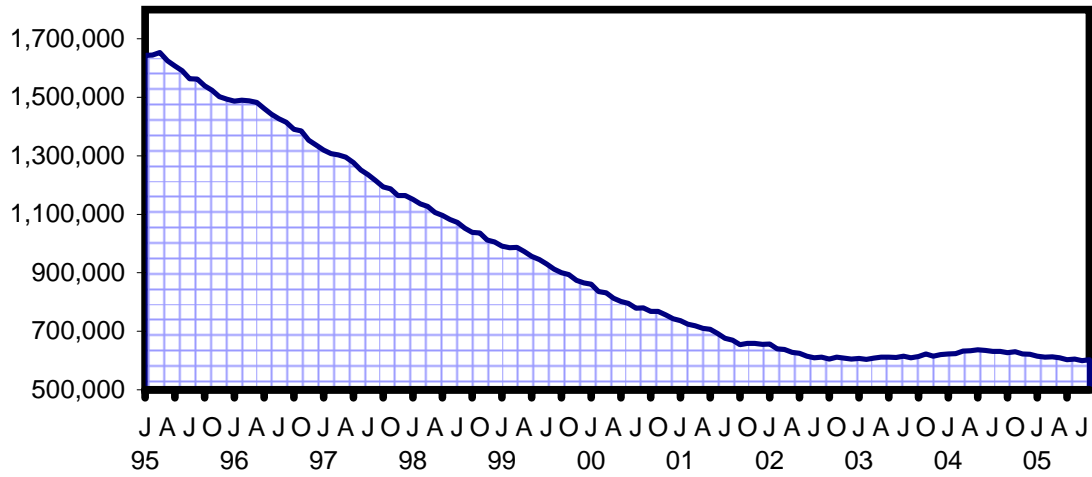
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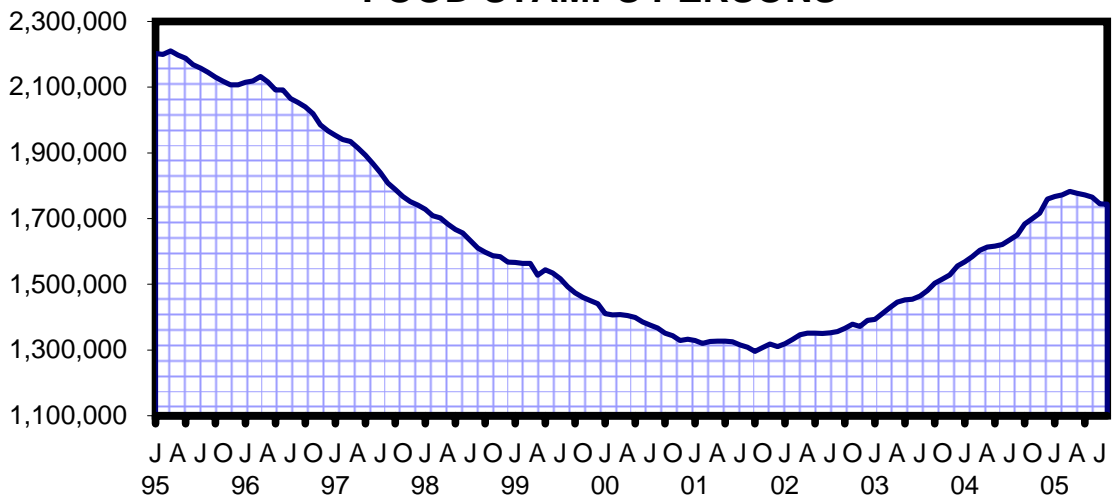

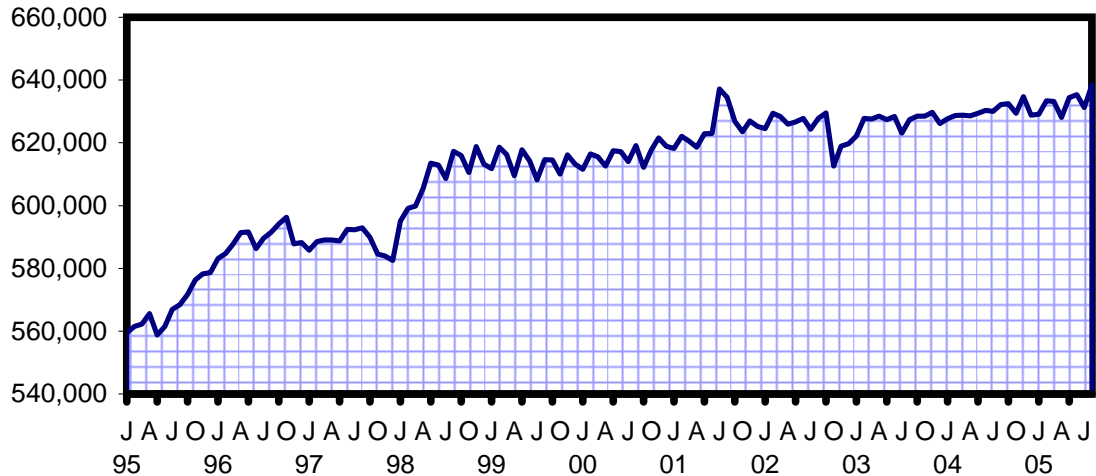
TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS
