The purpose of this GIS is to inform social services districts (districts) that the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) will be using a new short code phone number to send all future SNAP and P-EBT related text messages to households. Should districts receive any inquiries about forthcoming text messages, they will be able to confirm that the messages are legitimate and not a scam or spam.

Since 2020, OTDA has employed largescale text blasts to inform households of P-EBT issuances, as well as the termination of supplemental SNAP Emergency Allotments. As noted in <u>23 TA/DC011</u>, the most recent targeted text effort sent messages from 1-877-902-0684. Going forward, text messages will no longer be sent from 1-877-902-0684, and will instead be sent from the short code **696832**.
