Section 2

The purpose of this GIS is to inform social services districts (districts) of households that may be eligible for the 2022-2023 Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) Regular supplement benefit.

OTDA has identified households that received a lower amount for the Regular benefit during the 2022-2023 program year and may not have received a supplement benefit. A district-specific spreadsheet will be sent to HEAP Coordinators under a separate cover identifying these households.

The upstate systems bureau also provided two reports in the Production Hosting Reports & Enterprise Documents (PHRED) system identifying households that may be eligible for the supplement benefit but did not receive a supplement on the February 2023 HEAP Supplement Autopay. Households identified on the attached list may be included on these reports:
