The purpose of this GIS is to advise social services districts (districts) that the LDSS-5215: "Request for Replacement of Stolen Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and/or Temporary Assistance (TA) Cash Benefits" is now available online through myBenefits. The online request form is available in all 13 required languages.

Individuals in Rest of State (ROS) districts may now log into their myBenefits account to access, complete and submit the request form for replacement of electronically stolen (skimmed) benefits.

Once an individual completes and submits the online version of the replacement request form, the district can view and access the completed request form via the myWorkspace Undercare

Inbox using the Search For dropdown: "Benefit Replacement." For more information see myBenefits/myWorkspace/IEDR Release Notes 24.4.1.

Individuals may request replacement of either SNAP or TA cash benefits using this form. However, SNAP benefits stolen after December 20th, 2024 are not able to be replaced. Districts are reminded to continue to accept and determine SNAP replacement claims according to procedures described in <u>GIS 24DC82</u>, and to retain a record of denied claims in the event that any retroactive replacement is authorized.

Guidance on the replacement procedure for SNAP and TA cash benefits can be found in <u>23-ADM-07</u> and <u>GIS 24DC82</u>.

Districts are reminded to widely promote the availability of the EBT Card Freeze feature, as described in 24DC075, to assist individuals in protecting their benefits from theft.
