Section 2 - 2025-2026 Regular HEAP Benefit Component Opening Date

This GIS is to inform social services district (districts) that the 2025-2026 Regular HEAP benefits component will open on Monday, December 1, 2025.

Section 3 - Regular HEAP Benefit Applications

Effective December 1, 2025, districts must begin accepting applications for Regular HEAP benefits. Districts may use the LDSS-5000 (Rev. 7/22), Home Energy Assistance Program - Guarantee of Payment Letter (GOP) to assist households eligible for the Regular HEAP benefit facing an energy crisis, including: a utility shutoff, the threat of termination, low fuel or no fuel. The GOP may be sent to the household's Regular benefit vendor to ensure immediate deliverable delivery or prevent utility suspension.

The Regular HEAP benefit is scheduled to operate through April 7, 2026, or until funding is exhausted, whichever occurs first. Districts will be notified via GIS of any program operation date changes.

All applicants outside of New York City (NYC) may apply for Regular HEAP benefits online through my8enefits. Applicants who reside in NYC may apply for Regular HEAP benefits online through ACCESS HRA. The HEAP application will be available on my8enefits and ACCESS HRA. The HEAP application will be available on my8enefits and ACCESS HRA starting December 1, 2025.

Applicants may also apply for Regular HEAP benefits statewide by submitting paper applications by mail, fax, or in person at a district or alternate certifier. A list of <u>local district HEAP offices</u> may be found on OTDA's website. A printable HEAP Application (LDSS-3421) will be available for public download on the OTDA Website starting December 1, 2025.
