Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance: Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 584,874 in February 2013, decreasing by 811 (-0.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$187,842,487 in February 2013, decreasing by approximately \$1.1 million (-0.6%) over January 2013.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,153,979 in February 2013, decreasing by 4,562 (-0.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$461,411,806 in February 2013, decreasing by approximately \$2.7 million (-0.6%) over January 2013.

Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income: Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 702,922 in February 2013, decreasing by 1,045 (-0.2%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$409,892,192 in February 2013, decreasing by approximately \$1.7 million (-0.4%) over January 2013.

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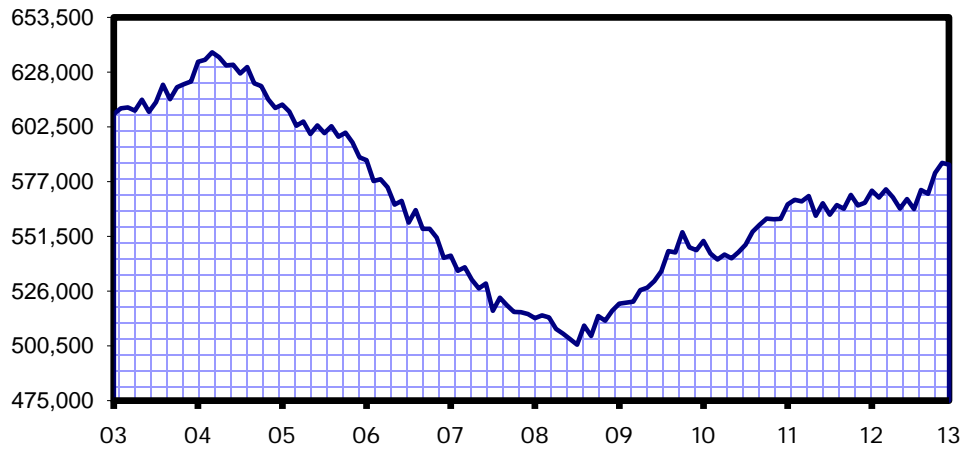
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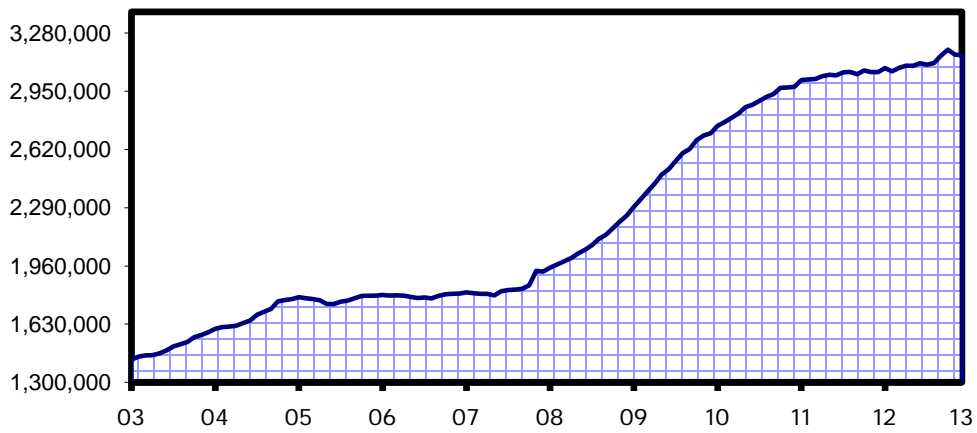
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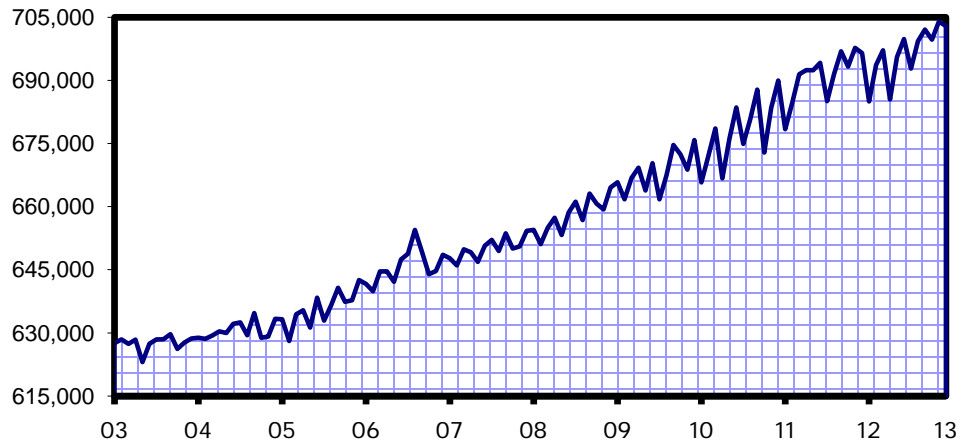
