# Temporary and Disability Assistance Statistics

## AUGUST 2015

---

### Temporary Assistance

Temporary Assistance recipients totaled 572,799 in August 2015, decreasing by 651 (-0.1%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$182,915,223 in August 2015, decreasing by approximately \$2.7 million (-1.5%) over July 2015.

### Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients totaled 3,001,608 in August 2015, decreasing by 15,996 (-0.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$421,578,916 in August 2015, increasing by approximately \$1.6 million (+0.4%) over July 2015.

### Supplemental Security Income

Supplemental Security Income recipients (including Mental Hygiene) totaled 710,698 in August 2015, decreasing by 3,402 (-0.5%) from the previous month. Related expenditures totaled \$423,112,493 in August 2015, increasing by \$489,145 (+0.1%) over July 2015.

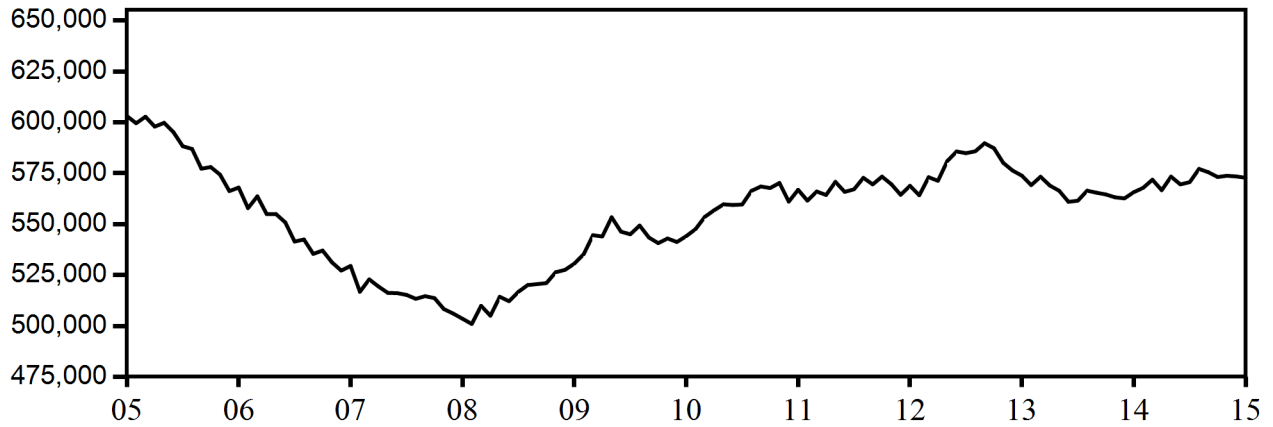

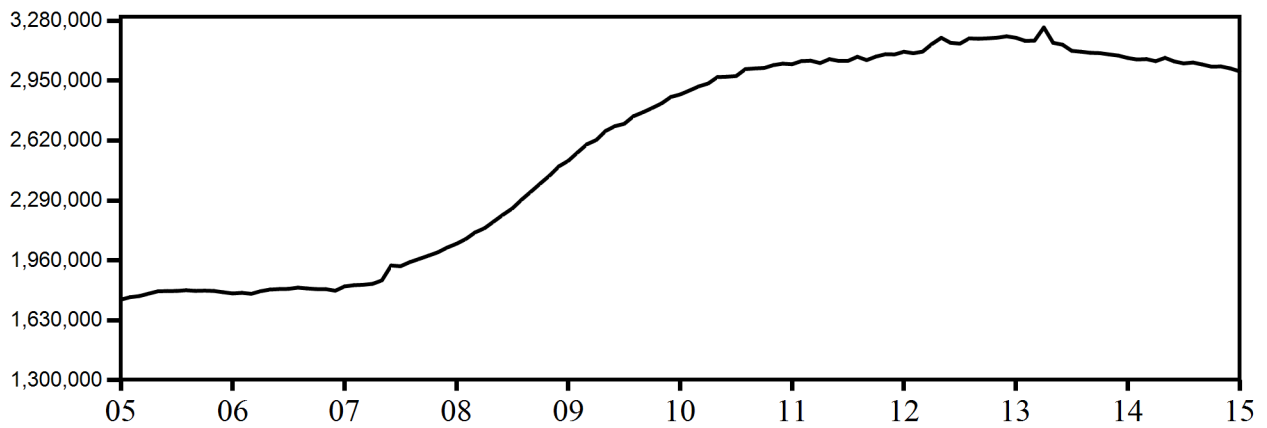

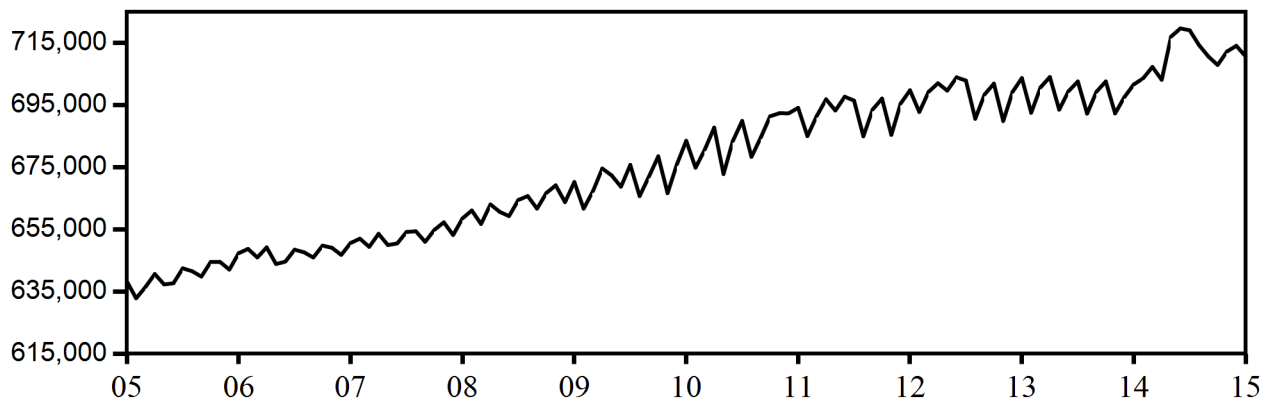
