The household, person and benefit amounts for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program have been revised downward from the initial publication of this report. This is because the initial report inadvertently included benefits issued to New York City recipients under the Pandemic EBT program, which is technically not a SNAP benefit. This error affected both the New York City and New York State counts, and resulted in an overcount of 8,346 households, 12,291 persons and \$66,537,481 in benefits.

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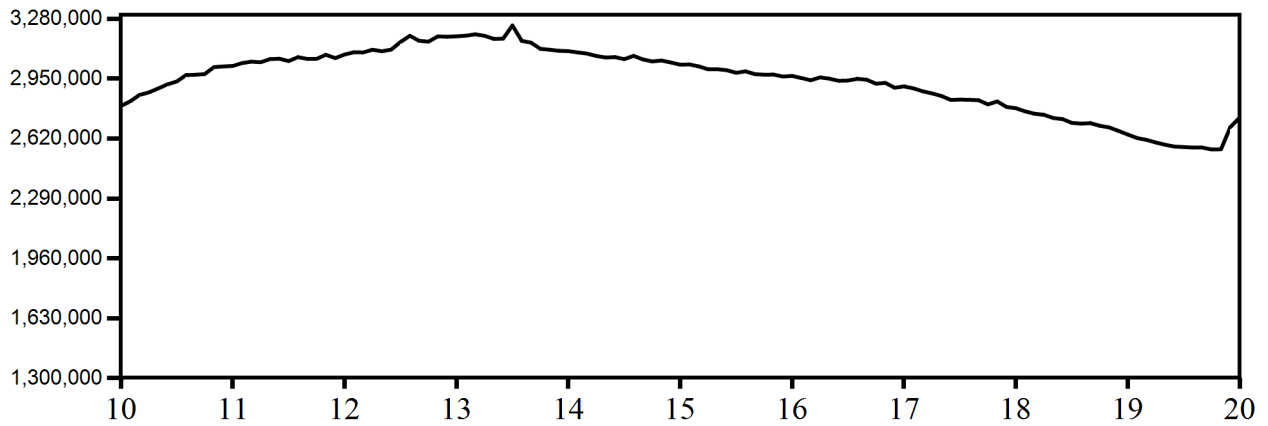

TEN YEAR TREND**

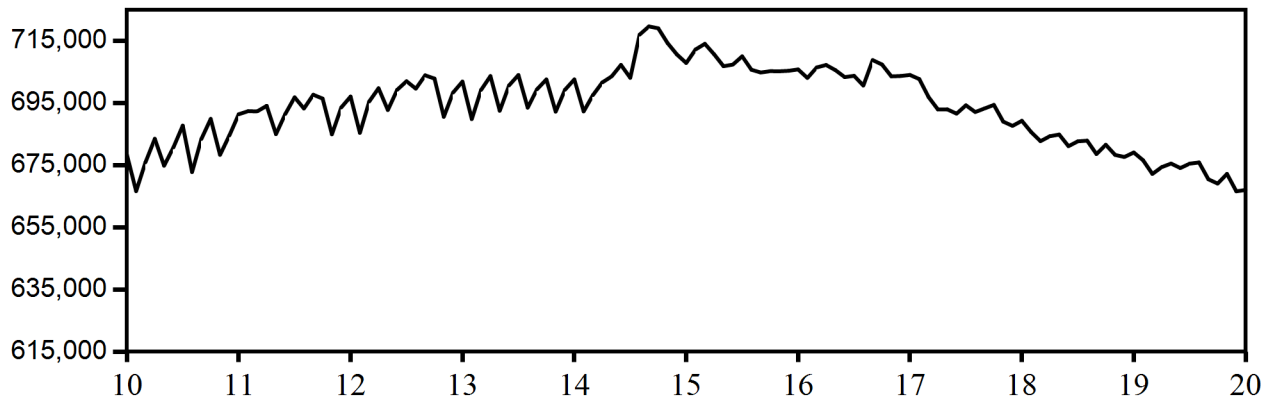
Temporary Assistance Recipients

This error affected both the New York City and New York State counts, and resulted in an overcount of 8,346 households, 12,291 persons and \$66,537,481 in benefits.
